The **UNIT** number and the term it will count towards.

Each assignment has **3 levels of homework**. Level 1 is only by invitation from the teacher. Level 2 are the problems that most students will do. Level 3 is for students who are capable of more complex math work.

A **Study Guide (SG)** will be assigned each unit to help students be ready for the unit test. Students will have approximately **2 weeks** to complete this assignment. It should be completed **BEFORE** the unit test is given.

**Unit Tests and Walkaways** are at the end of each unit. Approximately 10 questions on each unit test will count as the Walkaway for that unit. Walkaways are single core concept tests. We will follow the school's procedures on Walkaway Tests. Students will be required to pass all Walkaways with a score of 80% or higher. In order to retake a Walkaway, students will be required to fix problems they missed on the Walkaway **and** complete homework assignments leading up to the Walkaway. If a student has not passed the Walkaways for that term, he or she will receive an "I" (in progress) for their grade until each Walkaway is passed.

**Extra Credit** is offered at the end of each chapter. Students can choose to do it or not. Students will need to do all of the Extra Credit assignments in order to receive the Extra Credit at the end of the term. This will bump the final grade one step. (Ex. B+ to A-) **I will NOT offer individual students special extra credit assignments at the end of the term.**

At the end of each unit is a **DEAD DAY**. This is when the assignments from the unit will become dead. Checked and completed assignments handed in on or before the **DEAD DAY** could get full credit, 10 points (100% on the assignment). Assignments handed in after the **DEAD DAY** will be worth half credit.
